

MUST Ministries – work readiness program. They assist individuals with developing resumes, preparing for interviews, how to fill out an application, and job search options.

Chattahoochee Technical College – provides GED classes.

Goodwill Industries – Career center. They assist individuals with resume building, networking, practice job interview, how to dress for success and what employees expect. Trainings are also offered along with referrals to local businesses who are growing and have openings.

Georgia Hope Center – provides counseling services to families in the home.

Highland Rivers – A mental health program that provides services for the disabling effects of mental health, developmental disabilities, and addiction diseases.

Cherokee County Department of Family and Children Services – assists Cherokee County residents with TANF, Food Stamp, Medicaid assistance and CAPS.
